Tim Rushton was born in Lancashire in 1960. In 1978 he went to the University of Reading to read music. Upon graduation in 1981 he took up a post on the University staff. He left this post after a year to go to the University of Manchester to read for a masters degree in music. He is now researching eighteenth-century English music at the University College of North Wales.

He is the author of several articles on aspects of eighteenth-century music, some of which have been published.

Tim Rushton has given numerous recitals all over the British Isles, including in particular the complete organ voluntaries of John Stanley (London, November 1981), the Organ Concerto in G minor by Poulenc, with the Basingstoke Symphony Orchestra (March 1983) and in June, this year, he gave the first performance of William Smethergell's Favourite Concerto with the Redlands String Trio.

He had held organist's appointments at Edenfield Parish Church in Lancashire, and St. Mary Tadley, Hants., where he still directs the Tadley Concert Series. He is now organist of Holyhead Parish Church.
