Tim Rishton was born in Lancashire in 1960. After graduating with a B.A. in Music from the University of Reading in 1978, he took up a post on the staff of the University. After a year he went to the University of Manchester to read for an M.Mus. Tim is currently researching 18th century music for his Ph.D. at U.C.N.W.

He has held a number of organist posts, in particular Edderfield Parish Church, Lancashire, and S. Mary's, TADLEY, Hants., where he still conducts the Tadley Concert Series.

As a soloist, Tim has given performances in many areas of the country, including Poulencs Organ Concerto in G. minor and the complete organ works of John Stanley. In May 1983 he gave the first performance of William Smethergall's "Favourite Concerto".
