Timothy Rishton, Organist and Master of the Choristers of the Collegiate Church of Holyhead, was trained at Reading and Manchester Universities, where he won several organ-playing awards. He now works at the University of Wales. He regularly gives recitals in cathedrals, universities and colleges throughout Britain, Northern Europe and Scandinavia, specialising in music of the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries. He has recorded for the Welsh company Sain, and broadcasts frequently on radio and television.

He is also well known as a lecturer and author, and his scholarly work on instrumental music of the eighteenth century has won several awards. He has published several articles, contributed a chapter to a recent book and is now working on a translation of a music textbook into Welsh.
