Tim Rishton studied music at the Universities of Wales, Manchester and Reading, where he won every available prize in organ playing. At the age of 21 he was appointed to the full-time staff at Reading University and since 1983 has lectured at the University of Wales at Bangor. He is most familiar in Wales through numerous broadcasts on HTV and S4C and on the radio, though he has also made a number of records and written many articles and part of a book on music. He is a member of the 'blue robe' of Gorsedd y Beirdd.

He has now decided to give up teaching and move to the small and beautiful Arctic island of Luroy in Northern Norway, where, with his wife Tracey he will live between recital tours which in the next two years include venues as far apart as the USA and the Far East.
