A SPECIAL bi-lingual workshop for musicians wanting to accompany church choirs is to take place in Llangefni parish church on Anglesey.

The workshop will be open to people of all denominations and will cover such areas as the practicalities of accompanying services — on the organ, conducting a church choir and discussing the role of music in worship.

## Musicians' workshop

The one-day workshop is on November 18 and will end with a chance to sing some less wellknown hymns with members of Cor o Fawl.

Participants are welcome to bring their own instrument.

The workshop is being run under the auspices of Bangor University's Extral-Mural Studies department and with the co-operation of the North Wales Organ Music Foundation.

It builds on a practical course for church organists currently being run in Llangefni.

One of the directors of the workshop, Tim Rishton, said its aim was to help broaden people's idea of church music and to encourage a greater participation in it.
